  - DONE! (Continuously revised)
- <u>Phase 2&3 Clerkship & Post-Clerkship Phases</u> -
  - Intended, but not accomplished.
  - 2014 LCME Site visit put any potential changes on hold.

# **Guiding Principles (GP):**

- 1). Create core **clinical learning experiences** for learners to meet our program objectives and to develop competence for future practice.
- 2). **Individualize learning** to foster continued development and to prepare learners for the next stage of training.
- 3). **Organize** clinical learning experiences **developmentally** to ensure that learners are engaging in authentic roles in **increasing complex environments** as they demonstrate competence.
- 4). Align change with accreditation standards and emerging best practices in clinical education.
- 5). **Sustain** structures that's support learners' sense of community and developing professional identity. (**4-College System**)
- 6). Continue to **integrate clinical and basic science** across all phases of the curriculum.

- Med Ed Management Team finalized draft with components from 3 proposals Jan 2020

### When does this start?

- Phase 2 Changes begin March 2021
  - SMD23 last class to take Boards before clerkships
  - SMD23 Phase 2= March-Dec 2021
  - SMD24 first class to take Boards after clerkships
  - SMD24 Phase 2 = Jan- Oct 2022 on
  - No Phase 2 students around Nov/Dec each year
- Phase 3 changes begin Jan 2022
  - EM already working with INOVA adding a week of Point of Care Ultrasound to 3 week course
  - Need to plan ICU curriculum
