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2010 Next Gen Curricular Innovation Plan:

- Phase 1 – Pre-Clerkship – Organ-System Based; Active Learning; Integrated Basic Science and Clinical Significance
 - **DONE!** (Continuously revised)
- Phase 2&3 - Clerkship & Post-Clerkship Phases -
 - **Intended**, but not accomplished.
 - 2014 LCME Site visit put any potential changes on hold.

Why Change Now?

Guiding Principles (GP):

- 1). Create core **clinical learning experiences** for learners to meet our program objectives and to develop competence for future practice.
- 2). **Individualize learning** to foster continued development and to prepare learners for the next stage of training.
- 3). **Organize** clinical learning experiences **developmentally** to ensure that learners are engaging in authentic roles in **increasing complex environments** as they demonstrate competence.
- 4). **Align** change **with accreditation standards** and emerging **best practices** in clinical education.
- 5). **Sustain** structures that's support learners' sense of community and developing professional identity. (**4-College System**)
- 6). Continue to **integrate clinical and basic science** across all phases of the curriculum.

- Spring Joint Clerkship Meeting 2019- Phase 2&3 proposal presented
- Call for other Curriculum proposals- Sum 2019
- November 20, 2019 Curriculum Retreat
 - 65-70 Attendees (Chairs/RD/CD/Ed Comm. Members)
 - 3 proposals presented & feedback obtained
 - Recommendations for Phase 3 by specialty
- Med Ed Management Team finalized draft with components from 3 proposals Jan 2020
- RC +MJB met with several Dept. Chairs



Planning Process:

- CC reviewed & approved final proposal Feb 2020
- COVID distraction March-July 2020
- COVID dictated curricular changes sooner than expected June 2019
- CD Retreats & Planning x 5 with INOVA
- Selection Intersession Course Directors Oct 2020
- CC reviewed & approved new clerkship block proposals- Oct/Nov/Dec 2020
- Currently – CD's fine tuning curriculum
- Start Nex Gen Phase 2 -March 2021
- Spring 2021- focus on changes to Phase 3

When does this start?

- Phase 2 Changes begin March 2021
 - SMD23 last class to take Boards before clerkships
 - SMD23 Phase 2= March-Dec 2021
 - SMD24 first class to take Boards after clerkships
 - SMD24 Phase 2 = Jan- Oct 2022 on
 - No Phase 2 students around Nov/Dec each year
- Phase 3 changes begin Jan 2022
 - EM already working with INOVA – adding a week of Point of Care Ultrasound to 3 week course
 - Need to plan ICU curriculum
