



OUR MISSION

The purpose of the Colonnade Club is to foster social, cultural, and intellectual interchange among members and to promote the welfare of the University and its faculty.

On October 6, 1817, the cornerstone of the University of Virginia was placed at Pavilion VII in a ceremony attended by Presidents Jefferson, Madison, and Monroe. Originally, the Pavilion was used as a library before serving as home to three professors in succession.

STEEPED IN HISTORY

In 1907, 42 faculty members came together to form a faculty club for the University to foster social connections and the free exchange of ideas. The Club's use of Pavilion VII began when the Club was established, and we're honored to still operate out of the space. Pavilion VII is the oldest building in Jefferson's Academical Village, which is included on the UNESCO World Heritage List.

Today, the Colonnade Club has surpassed 1,000 members and is composed of an inspirational and diverse group of faculty, staff, alumni, and friends of the University. The Pavilion has benefited from two major additions (in 1855 and 1913) as well as a restoration in 2001, making the space well suited to support the future of the Club and the University. The Club also has gathering and office space in Hotel E, next door to the Pavilion VII Garden.

For more than a century, the Colonnade Club has been forging interdepartmental connections that help members find their place and make their mark. Join us.

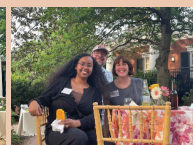


SOCIALIZE ON AND OFF GROUNDS

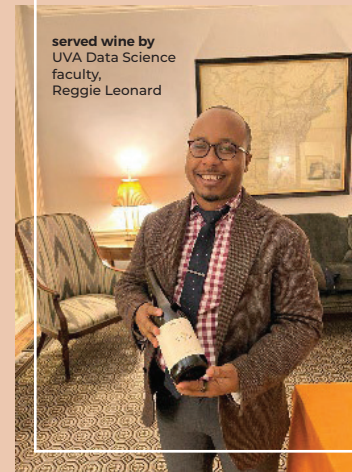

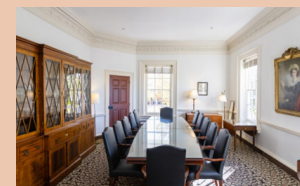


ACADEMIC & BUSINESS RENTALS
